

SECTION IV. PENALTY

(Adopted November 11, 1988 by Resolution 88-129, effective December 22, 1988)

- 4.01 Except as otherwise provided in this Resolution, violation of the provisions of this Resolution or failure to comply with any of its requirements, including violations of conditions and safeguards established in various sections of this Resolution, shall constitute a minor misdemeanor. Any person who violates this Resolution or fails to comply with any of its requirements shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), and in addition shall pay all costs and expenses involved in the case. Each day such violation continues after receipt of a violation notice shall be considered a separate offense. The owner, tenant, and/or occupant of any property, building, structure, premises or part thereof is responsible for maintaining said property, building, structure, premises or part thereof in compliance with all provisions of this resolution. The owner, tenant or occupant of any building, structure, premises, or part thereof, and any architect, builder, contractor, agent, or other person who commits, participates in, assists in or maintains such violation may each be found guilty of a separate offense and suffer the penalties herein provided. Nothing herein contained shall prevent Painesville Township from taking such other lawful action as is necessary to prevent or remedy any violation. (Revised February 26, 1998 by Resolution 98-23.)
